


Europe's 2020 strategy



Role of public procurement



Europe 2020 Flagship Initiative Innovation Union



"From 2011, Member States and regions should <u>set aside</u> <u>dedicated budgets</u> for pre-commercial procurements and public procurements of innovative products and services. (...)

This should create procurement markets across the EU starting from <u>at least €10 billion a year for innovations</u> that improve the efficiency and quality of public services, while addressing the major societal challenges."

- Improve value for money;


Smart use of procurement:



ASSISTANCE TO INTERESTED PROCURERS

Criteria for selection

- Concrete interest / commitment to start a PCP/PPI project and maturity of the business case;
- Potential impact of the PCP/PPI procurement;
- 3. Geographical balance of the cases to be assisted across Europe; and
- 4. Lack of experience and existence of prior cases in the implementation of PCP/PPI under the legal system of the country.
